






Our Lady smiled at the children saying; "Learn to read, and say the Rosary every day."




The children's parents did not believe them so they were taken to their priest to tell him about Our Lady. They were very afraid as they told the truth, but he also did not believe them.






Our Lady told the children that a chapel needed to be built in the Cova, in order to bring peace to the world and to save souls by the power of prayer.




