Now accepting applications for the 2021-2022 Academic Year

For the 2021-22 academic year, the Catholic Community Foundation is proudly offering multiple \$3,000 Mary Fran Carroll Scholarships to residents of Sarasota County, Florida for tuition, books and fees at an accredited college, university or vocational program. Each scholarship can be renewed annually up to 5 years for qualified students. (See website for eligibility requirements and application.)



Traditional Scholarships: Academic scholarships of \$3,000 each will be available to residents of Sarasota County, Florida. These educational opportunities are open to graduating seniors and recent high school graduates (within the last 2 years) from Catholic, private or public high schools in Sarasota County, Florida who wish to pursue an undergraduate degree in any accredited college or university.

Non-traditional Scholarships: Academic scholarships of \$3,000 each will be available to residents of Sarasota County, Florida. These educational opportunities are open to adult learners who are returning to school to obtain a college degree or vocational certification after being out of high school for three or more years (non-traditional students).
